Criteria

- Will protect, steward or create a tourism-related facility with an impactful life of greater than 10 years
 - Said facility will have a substantial use by visitors
- Has a clear timeline and measurable outcomes within the next 12 months
 - Has grassroots, community support







Commitments

- Stakeholder buy-in and support Funded by Transient Room Tax (TRT)
- Diverse, independent council established to approve projects
 - Land manager and governmental liaisons (non-voting)
 - Data-driven


• FY23 Projects

The Bend Sustainability Fund reinvests tax revenue generated by visitors into projects working to protect, steward and create sustainable experiences in Bend and the surrounding community.





