




















Transporting Tables





MAGICAL MURALS



LARGE, HAND-PAINTED MURALS have been popping up across Central Oregon in recent years, thanks to city code changes and eager local artists. The "Greetings From..." series on the Central Oregon Mural Trail by local artists Karen Eland and Katie Daisy draws inspiration from vintage postcards. At the La Pine Chamber of Commerce and Visitors Center, a bear, campfire and wildflowers give the mural a homey, rustic feel. Bright and lively with horses, butterflies and vibrant florals, the "Greetings From Sunriver" mural can be found behind the main lodge of Sunriver Resort seasonally. Other stops on the Central Oregon Mural Trail include the Oasis Cabin Resort in Maupin, an alley mural on SW Evergreen Avenue in Redmond and the Sisters mural at Barclay Bark. The newest additions from the artist duo can be found in on Fifth Street in Madras and in Bend's Old Mill District.

MORE MURALS TO SEE

Find more large, creative installations decorating the rest of the region.

"OREGON IS MAGIC" | PRINEVILLE

A part of the Oregon Mural Trail, and the "Oregon is Magic" series, find this mural at Crooked Roots Brewing in Prineville. The illustration depicts someone lying on the lush grass, surrounded by wildflowers and staring up at the clouds.

"SHÚKWAT" AND "TA'AMINWA NAM AP'XTAT" | WARM SPRINGS

The "Shúkwat" mural by Jefferson Greene can be found on the Warm Springs Community Action Team building, depicting vibrant blues, an eagle and a horse. The "Ta'aminwa Nam Ap'xtat" mural by Winona Garrison is a scene of mountains and rivers with wildlife and imagery from Indigenious cultures.

City Ceremonies IN-TOWN VENUES OF CENTRAL OREGON Cozy Convenience An in-town wedding offers convenience for guests and vendors. McMenamins Old St. Francis School is a former Catholic elementary school turned hotel, restaurant and entertainment venue in downtown Bend. The Oxford Hotel a few blocks away offers a ballroom venue and all-inclusive packages. Celebrate Bend's craft brewery scene with a vedding or reception at 10 Barrel Brewing Co's east side location, with banquet space above the pub. Riverhouse on the Deschutes sits riverside in the heart of Bend with hotel lodging, making it a great venue for scenic photography while still in town. At Campfire Hotel in Bend, plan an intimate ceremony near the outdoor pool or firepit. In Redmond, plan a rooftop wedding at SCP Redmond Hotel, a renovated historic hotel downtown, or tie the knot at Grace and Hammer, a historic church turned pizza eatery. Tour the Central Oregon Mural Trail



Stop #8 – La Pine

Head south from Sunriver to La Pine – the last stop on the trail, but ironically the first. La Pine was the first location on the trail to receive the vintage postcard-inspired 'Greeting From...' mural. The rustic town is the gateway to the Newberry Crater, and to glorious lakes with opportunities to kayak and paddleboard. The "Greetings From La Pine" mural shows a cozy, fireside camping night—a popular activity for the area—with a cabin on a peaceful lake; this is exactly what to expect when visiting. Before leaving La Pine, try a juice–packed hard cider at Legend Cider in the heart of town.

Stop #1 – Redmond Municipal Airport

Flying into town? Start your journey on the Central Oregon Mural Trail at the Redmond Municipal Airport. When waiting eagerly to begin your trip around the region, don't forget to check out the "Greetings From Central Oregon" mural located at the Visit Central Oregon visitor's desk at baggage claim, proudly displaying signature pine trees centered around a towering mountain scene: exactly what to expect from your trip here.

Stop #6 – Bend

Drive to the heart of Central Oregon, the town of Bend, and find nothing but outdoor activities, amazing food and shopping galore. While strolling along the Deschutes River Trail in the Old Mill District, take a look at the series' newest mural, "Greetings From Bend." Like the Sisters mural, this piece of art also showcases the Cascade Range mountains, but from Bend's perspective. Stunning wildflowers, butterflies and grassy plains show all the opportunity for exploration there is in town—and just outside of town.
