What Is an Oregon Destination Association (ODA) Member

Destination Marketing and Management Organizations (aka: DMOs) are primarily not-for-profit organizations that represent a specific destination such as a city, county or region. DMOs serve as the official contact points for their destination marketing and management, for meeting professionals, tour operators and leisure travelers.

DMOs sell the city, county or region and operate in a stewardship capacity for the visitor industry and their destination.

Each DMO is a product of the tourism requirements of the city, county or region it serves. Generally, DMOs receive funding support from transient occupancy tax and are often an independent non-profit organization contracted by the city, county or region to market tourism. Some DMOs are membership based; others are not.

DMO Dues are based on the DMOs total Annual Budget:

\$25 million and above	\$5,000	
\$5 million and above	\$3,000	
\$2.5 - \$5 million	\$2,000	
\$1 million - \$2.5 million	\$1,000	
\$500,000 - \$999,000	\$ 700	
\$250,000 - \$499,000	\$ 500	
Under \$250.000	\$ 300
